



Center for ReSource Conservation ReWards 2009 Request for Nominations

Deadline: April 10, 2009

The Center for ReSource Conservation's ReWards are Boulder County's most prestigious award for the **conservation** of natural resources.

There are **four categories** for which an individual or group of individuals can receive recognition:

- * **Waste Reduction**

The Waste Reduction ReWard will go to a Boulder County individual or group of individuals who have advanced the diversion of waste from landfills through re-use, recycling or composting.

- * **Energy Conservation**

The Energy Conservation ReWard will go to the individual or group of individuals who have demonstrated a commitment to the advancement of the cause, policy and implementation of energy efficiency and/or renewable energy within Boulder County.

- * **Water Conservation**

The Water Conservation ReWard will go to a Boulder County individual or group of individuals who have made advances in the conservation of water resources.

- * **Community Conservation**

The Community Conservation ReWard will go to the individual or group of individuals who have demonstrated outstanding leadership and creative vision toward a more sustainable future for Boulder County through the principles of conservation and environmental protection.

ReWard recipients receive a plaque honoring their outstanding achievement. The CRC will widely promote the name and accomplishments of the Reward recipients for the purpose of providing much deserved recognition and raising awareness about conservation of natural resources and inspiring others to become engaged in similar conservation activities.

To be considered, nominations must be received by April 10, 2009. The CRC selection committee will notify all nominees of their nomination and thank them for their outstanding conservation efforts as well as select the recipient of the 2009 ReWards. The Center for ReSource Conservation provides financial and administrative support for the awards and the annual award reception.

Nomination Requirements:

- Description (1500 words or less) to include:
 - Accomplishments and contributions
 - Inspirational value to conservation community
 - Impact on the community
 - Examples of leadership, vision, and innovation
- Up to two attachments (photo, brochure, news clipping) that support the application

Suggestions for a Strong Application:

- Remember, the focus of the nominee's accomplishments and impact should be on efforts benefiting conservation of natural resources within Boulder County.
- Research what else your nominee is doing to conserve natural resources outside those efforts for which the nominee is known to you or your organization.
- Try to address the nominee's current and past achievements; while you might be focused on one particular achievement, the nominee may have other qualifications that you could address in the narrative.
- As you are writing, please think about how the nominee's accomplishments have made a difference and describe this in narrative instead of simply list form.
