Petroselinum
crispum 'Forest Green'

Parsley, curled

A favorite curled parsley. Long, stiff, upright stems help keep the double and triple curled leaves clean and allow for easy bunching. Good flavor, yield, and appearance.

Parsley, flat-leaf

Long, stiff, upright stems help keep the double and triple curled leaves clean and allow for easy bunching. Good flavor, yield, and appearance.

Garlic Chives

Garlic chives is a clump-forming onion family member which may be grown for both culinary and ornamental purposes. Features chive-like, gray-green leaves up to 12" long which may be used in cooking in the same manner as chives. Tiny, star-shaped, white flowers with brown striped tepals appear in loose clusters (umbels to 2" wide) atop leafless 9-18" stems in late summer into fall. All parts of the plant have an oniony smell when cut or crushed, however the flower scent is more suggestive of violets. Also commonly called Chinese chives because the plant is grown extensively in China for culinary purposes.



Salvia officinalis
'Tricolor'

Sage, Purple

Identical to the species in form and texture, with the difference being the leaves, which are variegated with gray-green, cream, and violet to purple-pink. May need more protection than the species.



Ocimum basilicum
'Genovese'

Basil, Sweet

A traditional Italian Basil. Authentic flavor and appearance. Tall and relatively slow to bolt with large, dark green leaves about 3" long. Ht. 24-30".

Basil, Red Rubin

Vigorous, purple, Italian Large Leaf type. High yields and great flavor. Flat, 3" long leaves stand out horizontally, and are a copper-tinged purple color. Ht. 18-24".

'Sativa'

Tarragon

This is the true french tarragon, an aromatic culinary herb with a mint-anise flavor. This variety rarely flowers, but it adds a wonderful aroma to the perennial or herb garden.



Lycopersicum
esculentum Celebrity

Celebrity Tomato

Great flavor in firm, 8-ounce crack-free fruits describes the Celebrity Hybrid (VFFNT) Tomato. Performs well in almost every region and under adverse conditions. Good blight tolerance and foliage cover.



Capsicum annum Ace Ace Sweet Bell Pepper

The extra-early, highly productive standard. Amazing yields of medium-sized, 3 to 4-lobed, green bell peppers. Has apparent resistance to blossom drop even in adverse weather. Nearly every flower produces a pepper. Glossy green fruits turn red early. Ace commonly produces heavy crops for Northern growers who have had little success growing peppers before.



Brassica oleracea
Nagoya

Nagoya Kale

Frilly, fan-shaped leaves with contrasting centers and green edges. The colors are most intense in cool weather.
